2024-2025 MIAGE Graduate Assistant – Research Focus (GR)

The Master of Science in International Affairs & Global Enterprise (MIAGE) program at the University of Utah invites applications for a GR position for the 2024-2025 academic year. The position is open to current and incoming MIAGE graduate students who can commit to full-time enrollment (9-12 credit hours) during the fall 2024 and spring 2025 semesters. GRs must maintain a GPA of 3.0/4.0 or higher during their enrollment in MIAGE.

The position requires a 20-hour per week commitment during both fall and spring semesters. Compensation for the 2024-2025 year has not been determined yet, but will likely be ~ \$10,000/semester and up to a 100% tuition waiver. The tuition waiver does not cover special fees nor does it cover differential tuition. Other limitations may apply and we encourage students to discuss with the Program Manager.

The MIAGE GR will primarily focus on project-based work that originates from their own ideas in consultation with the MIAGE Program Manager. Ideal projects should come from the GR's current and developing skill set and benefit the program as well as the GR's career goals.

A strong knowledge of one's own skills and strengths, as well as areas for development are desired. An ability to work with all types of people across many intersecting differences is essential. Because this position will also require regular communication with current and prospective MIAGE students as well as campus partners, good communication skills are a plus.
